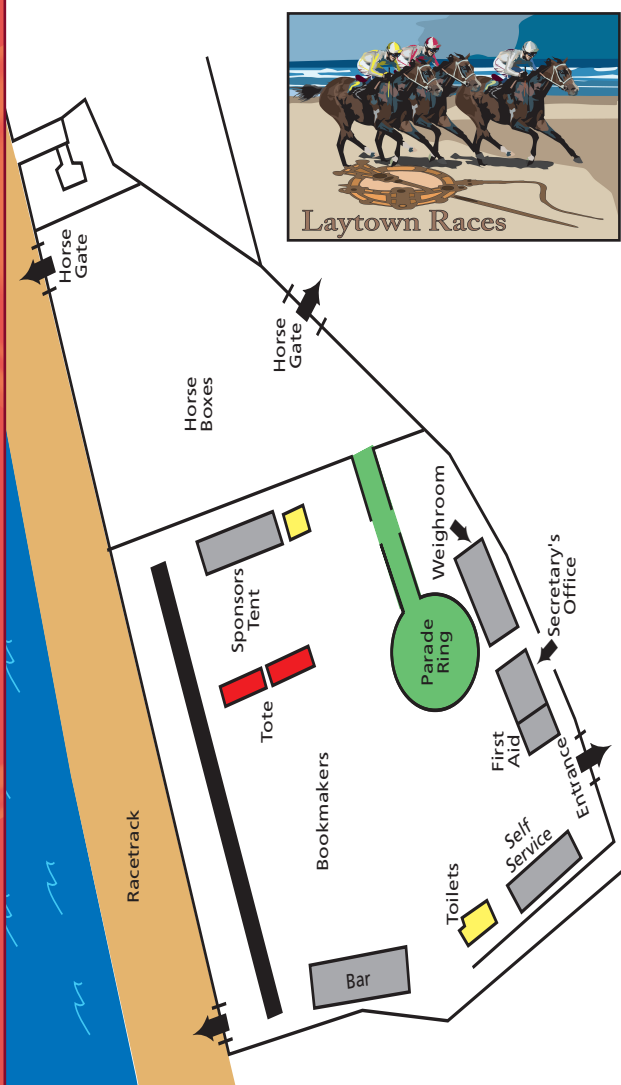

WITHDRAWN HORSES

NOTICE INSERTED BY THE BOOKMAKERS' ASSOCIATION

(to co-incide with Tattersalls' Rule 4 (c))

If a horse whose number appears in the Number Frame is withdrawn before a fair start has been effected **any bet made on such horse will be refunded by the Bookmaker.** Should the current odds against the withdrawn horse at the time of the official notification be set out hereunder the liability of the bookmaker will be reduced as follows:

Odds of Withdrawn Horse	Deduction from Winning
(a) 3-10 or shorter	75 cent in the €
(b) 2-5 to 1-3	70 cent in the €
(c) 8-15 to 4-9	65 cent in the €
(d) 8-13 to 4-7	60 cent in the €
(e) 4-5 to 4-6	55 cent in the €
(f) 20-21 to 5-6	50 cent in the €
(g) Evens to 6-5	45 cent in the €
(h) 5-4 to 6-4	40 cent in the €
(i) 13-8 to 7-4	35 cent in the €
(j) 15-8 to 9-4	30 cent in the €
(k) 5-2 to 3-1	25 cent in the €
(l) 100-30 to 4-1	20 cent in the €
(m) 9-2 to 11-2	15 cent in the €
(n) 6-1 to 9-1	10 cent in the €
(o) 10-1 to 14-1	5 cent in the €
(p) Longer than 14-1	No deductions

In the event of more than one horse being declared a non-starter, the deduction shall be calculated by the coupling of the odds of the horses concerned, e.g. two horses at 20 to 1 would represent 19-2. In such an event the total reduction shall not exceed 75 cent in the €.

NOTE: The Stake will not be subject to any deduction.

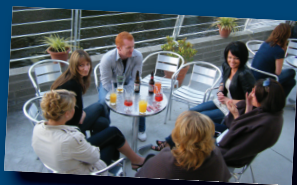

6. The Claim Form must be placed in a sealed envelope.
7. If more than one Claim is entered for the same horse, the highest bidder will be deemed successful.
8. Any claim, the documentation for which is incomplete or inaccurate is void.
9. When the successful claimant is announced, that person should immediately make payment in the form of bankers draft to the Clerk of the Course or his appointed deputy. Drafts should be made payable to 'The Turf Club'. Cash is not acceptable.
10. If the Bankers Draft is in excess of the successful claim amount, a balancing cheque will be forwarded from the office of the Governing Bodies to the claimant on the next working day.

LAYTOWN STRAND RACES TRIVIA

Laytown Races have been running for 140 years, the first ever recorded meeting was held in 1868.

Charles Stewart Parnell, the Home Rule Leader was an early named steward.

Five generations of the Delany family have been involved as stewards, trainers, jockeys, and course builders. The current Chairman of the Race Committee is Niall Delany of Corballis.
